

## **Epson's mission**

In 2018, Epson revised its Environmental vision 2050. As part of our Epson 25 renewed goals, we set global targets for reducing our greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions.

The Science Based Targets initiative (SBTi) has recognised and approved our reduction targets as being consistent with climate change science and in line with keeping a global temperature rise to 1.5°C. We have set a target for a 34% reduction in Scopes 1 and 2 emissions by fiscal year 2025 compared to fiscal year 2017 and a 44% reduction in Scope 3 emissions (Category 1: Purchased goods and services, and Category 11: Use of sold products) as a percentage of value added (business profit) before the end of fiscal year 2025 compared to fiscal year 2017. By 2030, we have pledged to reduce our total emissions in line with the 1.5°C scenario.

We intend to achieve this through reduction of the environmental impacts of our products and services, and in our supply chains. Scopes 1, 2 and 3 emissions are meant here as defined in the GHG Protocol. Scope 1 emissions are direct emissions from owned or controlled sources, Scope 2 emissions are indirect emissions from the generation of purchased energy and Scope 3 emissions are all indirect emissions (not included in Scope 2) that occur in the value chain of the reporting company, including both upstream and downstream emissions (Source: ghgprotocol.org).

The calculations made in this carbon footprint lifecycle assessment intend to only provide results on greenhouse gases emissions measured with CO<sub>2</sub>e metric.

Are included in these carbon footprint lifecycle calculations: greenhouse gases measurements on the product, its packaging and all elements accompanying the product in the packaging (manuals and others (including options/accessories)).

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
